² All experience in posts at any level in dentistry count, irrespective of the country the experience is gained.

^{*} You must provide the names and addresses of two referees, who are willing (have already consented) to provide clinical references relating to two posts undertaken within the last two years (one of which will usually be a current post) each of which lasted at least three months (continuous period) with out a significant break, or where this is not possible, a full explanation as to why that is the case and the names and addresses of two alternative referees. For example; Where posts have been of shorter duration or you have worked as a locum in a number of casual posts, you may include a referee from a frequently-held, recurrent post. These details must be provided directly to your employer after acceptance of an offer and allocation to practice.
